Making our school a little greener

Since October 2010, we have collected more than 50 lbs of batteries for recycling. These batteries are sent to Call2Recycle Canada, a program that was created in 1994 and is funded by battery and product manufacturers to raise awareness about the importance of battery recycling and to promote product stewardship initiatives.

New batteries and stainless steel products are made from the precious metals recovered from used batteries. Cell phones are recycled, refurbished and/or resold. None of the broken down material makes its way into landfills.

Our collection boxes are located in the front entrance to the school and in the office.
