VSB Battery Recycling Program



The VSB is rolling out a district-wide battery recycling program, serviced by Vancouver Battery. They have provided schools with two brown containers, located in the front hallway, to collect any used batteries. One container is for <u>rechargeable batteries</u> (NiCad, NiMH, cell phone, digital camera, camcorders, cordless phone etc.) and the other for <u>non-rechargeable</u> (alkaline, button cell, watch, hearing aid, calculators, car remotes, etc.). Please drop off any used batteries to the correct containers.

In addition to providing the recycling service, Vancouver Battery is offering discounts to people connected to this recycling program.

- Anyone such as school staff, students and parents can purchase batteries through Vancouver Battery at a 15% discount off of the retail price.
- Any school wishing to buy batteries will receive a corporate discount rate that is larger than the discount above. The corporate discount rate varies depending on the type of battery, so it is best to contact Vancouver Battery at 604-737-8463 directly to receive a quote.

Registration Information

We continue to accept new registrations for "in-catchment" students, Kindergarten (born in 2007) to Grade 7. To register at False Creek Elementary, students must be born in Canada and speak English as their home language. Please come to the office for an application or fill out the Student Application Form found on the VSB website. The following supporting documents are required:

- 1. Proof of address
 - current property tax statement
 - rental or lease agreement
 - current bank or credit card statement
- 2. Child's original birth certificate preferably the long one showing both parents names
- 3. Child's immunization records or any other important medical documents
- 4. School report cards most recent (for grades 1-7)
- 5. Any other relevant documents involving guardianship, court orders, etc.

We are happy to make copies of any documents at the school. The office is open for registration from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm. The registration period is from November 1, 2011-January 31, 2012.

Students who are not born in Canada or do not speak English as their home language must register at the District Reception and Placement Centre (DRPC). It is located at Moberly Elementary (east wing), 1000 East 59th Avenue. Registration at DRPC is from Monday – Friday, 8:30-11:00 am. The phone number to contact is 604-713-5999.
