
- Please include your personal email address with registration so that we may issue you a diploma and a tax deductable receipt. Tennis XL will not share information of add you to a mailing list.

Tennis In-Schools Program

Stage 1: INTRODUCTION

Delivered by Tennis XL, this fun, affordable program gives students a chance to play in a tennis program at school, with expert coaches who provide all the necessary equipment. Students have the opportunity of purchasing a Wilson tennis racquet so they can continue playing in the community (check with coach regarding this). The Program usually runs for one or two weeks. Those students with tennis experience are given the opportunity of acting as leaders and help mentor their classmates.

Benefits to students

- Students taught by Tennis XL certified coaches;
- Program provided at a lower cost than lessons available in a community centre;
- Increased participation levels of older children by keeping sports 'fun';
- It is a non-contact sport and is inherently not dangerous for participants.
- Increased physical, social and development skills in young children;
- Development of family sports resulting in families playing together;
- Opportunity to identify potential youth and community leaders;
- New physical activity students can continue outside of school with family and friends;

- It is a social sport a game that can be played by both males and females, in clubs and on public tennis courts, with family members, in tournaments and friendly games;
- Program teaches movement and sports skills within a framework of respect, fair play, and social responsibility;

- On-site training with no transportation issues or costs.

<u>Cost:</u> (two toonies) \$4.00 per student with subsidy from our PAC for 4 group lessons delivered during the regular school day – an amazing value! All equipment including nets, racquets and balls are provided. **Students should wear runners.**

<u>Format:</u> Tennis XL will be providing 4 tennis lessons to all students/grades, <u>during P.E. class time from February 8-16</u> to enrich their physical education program.
