Direct Donation Fundraising Drive

Many thanks to all who have already contributed to the Direct Donation Fundraising Drive. **The DIRECT DONATION Campaign**, now in its seventh year, is the **main fundraising initiative** of the False Creek Elementary School Parent Advisory Council (PAC).

False Creek School PAC is requesting a tax-deductible donation from each False Creek School family. We recommend an amount of **\$50.00** per child. This is a significant amount but will go a long way to address the many needs of our students and our school.

The DIRECT DONATION Campaign guarantees that 100% of the money raised benefits our children at False Creek School. Previous approaches garnered a fraction of that percentage (such as constantly asking parents to buy and have students sell things from outside sources like poinsettias, chocolates, emergency supplies, and cookbooks.)

Through additional fundraising programs, PAC aims to promote and provide services to our school and local community. These include a Weekly Lunch program (\$5000), various Social and Cultural Events (\$1000), Family Photo Sessions (\$1000), Lemonade Stand (\$800 - \$1500) as well as a few other programs.
