Emergency Drills



As part of our ongoing practice to prepare our students and staff for possible emergencies, we had a Fire Drill on October 4 and we will have another one before Term One ends. We also had an earthquake drill on October 12. Our first lockdown drill will be at the end of November.

We are expected to hold 6 fire drills, 2 earthquake drills and 2 lockdown drills every school year. We practice

these drills because we don't want children to be scared if emergencies do arise – i.e. we want them to practice ways of being safe if something unusual or possibly unsafe were to be happening in the school. We encourage you to discuss these drills with your children at home. If you have any questions or concerns, please ask your child's teacher or myself, the school administrator.

Safe Arrival and Sign-Out Procedures



The Vancouver School Board has

introduced a safe arrival protocol district wide. Information on this protocol went out in an email yesterday. If your child will be absent from school, please phone the school to report this absence as early as possible. Parents should leave a message on a dedicated answering service by calling (604) 713-5159 – enter the two digit extension for your school – 28 prior to 9 am on the first day of the absence. Upon calling the Safe Arrival phone line you will be asked to leave a message and will require the following information:

First & Last Name of your child (Please spell the last name) Grade & Division Reason for Absence Date & Length of Absence

When you pick up your child during the school day, please ensure that you sign them out at the school office.



These include a Weekly Lunch program (\$5000), various Social and Cultural Events (\$1000), Family Photo Sessions (\$1000), Lemonade Stand (\$800 - \$1500) as well as a few other programs.
