## SCHOOL TABLET FUNDRAISING DRIVE !!!

The school has asked for your help!
The VSB has been removing old tablets from schools for good reason:

- Older devices can become security risks
- Older devices can slow wifi for everyone
- etc...

Unfortunately, when they take old devices away, they don't
 always replace them.

False Creek is currently sharing 14 newish iPads, and 5-7 old iPad Minis (but their batteries are failing, and 16GB of storage doesn't store much), that isn't usually enough for a single class to use.

Ms Lee (our new Teacher Librarian) and Mr Watt (Division 3 Teacher) came to the last PAC meeting to ask the PAC to buy 10 new iPads. The new iPads each have 64GB of storage.

The ask is about $\$ 4100$. While the PAC can look for money from other sources, in these challenging times, it is ONLY direct donations that will make this possible.

If families donate about $\$ 20$ per child (we know not all families can), we can do this. $\$ 20$ per child is a lot, but it is a lot less than schools that just ask parents to send their kids to school with \$400 tablets!

For families who can, please consider donating more for families who can't.

## SALEEMA NOON PRESENTATIONS \& SURVEY

At the last PAC general meeting, the PAC voted to schedule Saleema Noon's organisation to give Body Science workshops at False Creek Elementary (more information can be seen here).
