- We had many fundraising events this year:
 - 2 movies nights
 - School dance
 - Spring it on carnival
 - Freezie sales (likely to be organized by grade 7s for grad fundraising)
 - Fridge has juice and Bubly as well that we can use for future events
- Social (Ian Matheson and Marie O'Mahony)
 - No new updates
- Budget (Catherine French)
 - We are sitting with a healthy balance
 - Final numbers are still coming in for Carnival on track to make approximately \$7,000 - 10,000
 - We received the gaming grant
 - \$6700 raised on hot lunches (excluding grade 6/7 pizza days)
 - There are a few more expenses for the remaining events in the year, but we are expecting a surplus
 - Camp fundraising
 - Annual grant from PAC: \$1750.00
 - 50% holiday bazaar: \$795.00
 - 50% Purdy's: \$430.00
 - Pizza sales: \$1689.00
 - Total: \$4664.00 (vs \$3034.93 previous year)
 - School decides how to spend this money towards the events
 - Grad/camp fundraising (either event)
 - PAC grant from PAC: \$600
 - Pizza hot lunch: \$1289
 - Valentine's day: \$174
 - Spring it on bracelets: \$400 (approx)
 - Total: \$2463.00
 - Grad committee typically puts some fundraising toward a gift to the school (usually a donation to next year's class)
 - We recommend future years to start the fundraising in September because the fundraising needs to be in early in order to make the payments at the appropriate times (camp payments need to be in earlier in the year)
