# 2024 / 2025 Budget

- We aim to make budget decision to support all students
- We keep a buffer of ~\$5800 to ensure our minimum functions. This leaves \$14,880 to plan for this year's budget

### Revenue

- We will have a campaign for parents to contribute a direct deposit through School Cash Online, which also provides a tax receipt
- The neighbourhood association (FCSNA) will be donating \$1000
- We apply for gaming grants and other possible grants on an annual basis
- We are budgeting for similar fundraisers as last year, e.g. dance, jolly jars, Spring it on carnival, Purdy chocolate sales, yearbook, etc.

### **Expenses**

- Arts & Culture e.g. Body science workshop, Supplies for clubs, Diversity events
- Sports and Recreation e.g. gymnastics, cross country / track and field staff coverage, new equipment, team jerseys, bike week initiatives
- o Literacy e.g. library books and supplies, classroom books
- o Science and Technology e.g. science workshops, TVs, laptops, garden club
- Class activities and supplies e.g. field trips, in class activities, supplies, grade
   6/7 grad camp, Purdy chocolate sales, Grade 7 grad
- School Community Building events e.g. PACnic, etc.
- Administrative fees e.g. supplies, bank fees, website, teacher retirement/thank you gifts
- We are projecting approximately \$9000 remaining at the end of the year

- Mr Rupert 3 years ago the province provided some money to support families in need.
  We will be planning to support families asking for some extra help as well as offsetting
  costs for all students. There are some rules around the funding, but we will communicate
  throughout the year how we'll be using the money. Depending on timing, the decision
  can be brought to the PAC meeting for voting or for small changes may go through the
  PAC executive.
