- 7. Krista: Options for Sexual Health Course update**

 - 14 hours total, \$183/hours,
 - \$2937 total for whole sexual health course
 - Classes happening the week of November 10th
 - No parent night this year (it can be booked for next year for additional cost)
 - Could a one-sheet sexual health info be given to parents? – Krista plans to make this to send out
 - Pros: Options for Sexual Health offers more time with each class (2 sessions per class) and a curriculum that is aligned with the BC Curriculum

14. FC South Neighbourhood Association Update: Roxanne

- There is a yearly \$1000 grant and we need to decide what to use the money for (Gr 6/7 camp, Options for Sexual Health course – TBD)

15. Budget (Natasha)

- Gaming grant received again this year (\$6,180)
- We have \$29,270 in chequing but a lot of this money will be spent to pay for hot lunch orders
- Pushing direct donations more this year. Amounts will increase in School PAC Donations as more donations come in
- Revenue: gaming grant, direct donations, SFCNA donation, hot lunch, plus any fundraising events that get planned
- We need to make direct donation tab clearer (under 'make a donation' tab school cash online) – maybe send screenshot with the info?
- Expenses: \$44,473 (requested by school)
- Projected Revenue: \$23,000
- We will need to make up this shortfall through events and fundraising/direct donations
- Rainbow Day: do we need so many knickknack items or could we reduce the plastic items? This money used to be part of the bigger Inclusivity Committee. Is anyone interested in taking on Inclusivity Committee?
- Motion to Pass Revised Budget with highlighted items on pause depending on fundraising outcomes: Motioned Krista Scaligine, Seconded Carly Carson, Passed unanimously
